**T**he 26-year-old actress has taken to social media to publicly announce her and her husband, Jamie Watson, are due to have "another big milestone" in 2018 as they are expecting their first child together. Alongside a photograph of the former 'Zoey 101' star with her spouse and her nine-year-old daughter Maddie - who Jamie has with her former partner Casey Aldridge - which was posted on her Instagram account, she wrote: "Looks like we are starting off 2018 with another big milestone...sooo happy to announce that Maddie is FINALLY going to be a big sister (sic)." In the heartfelt post Jamie revealed 2017 has been a difficult year for her as her child nearly drowned in an ATV accident. She continued: "2017 was filled with

some of the biggest challenges of my life, as well as some of the biggest blessings (sic)." And over the last 12 months Jamie decided to "lay low" to focus on herself and her career. She added: "So I made a choice to lay low this year to focus on truly becoming my best self as a person and as an artist. (sic)." Jamie has teased she has been working on new music, which she "can't wait" to share with her fans. She said: "During that time, I continued working on my music and telling my story, which has created some of my most honest work and I CANT wait to share that with you all very soon.(sic)." Although 2017 has been filled with "challenges" and "blessings" for Jamie, she thinks the next year will see her achieve "many milestones both personally and professionally". She con-

cluded her post: "2018 is going to be filled with many milestones both personally and professionally. The former 'Kocktails with Khloe' host has been swamped with well wishes from her fans, which proved too much for the reality star to take. In response to another fan's comment, she wrote: "Stop it! The American star - who also married Internet entrepreneur Alexis Ohanian earlier this year - plans to compete at the event ahead of defending her Australian Open title in Melbourne in January. Remarkably, Serena won the title last year while she was already two months pregnant. Australian Open tournament director Craig Tiley previously revealed Serena was intent on defending her crown Down Under. He shared: "She has got her visa, she has entered, she's practicing, and she probably just needs a bit more space for a bigger entourage. "There is no question she will be ready in our view." However, fans of the record-breaking star will be eager to see how she

balances her on-court demands with being a new mother. Serena has previously admitted to feeling stressed by the demands of raising her daughter. She recently reached out to her followers on social media for advice on how she can ease Alexis Olympia's suffering, because it is making her "stressed" and tearful. ### Teigen got stuck on an 8-hour flight to nowhere, and live-tweeted the whole thing

**C**hrissy Teigen and John Legend spent eight hours on a flight from LAX to Tokyo which had to be turned around. The Sports Illustrated model - who is pregnant with the couple's second child - has been live-tweeting the disaster journey on her Twitter account for most of yesterday). Chrissy - who already has baby girl Luna with the 'All of Me' singer, who it is not known was on the plane with her parents or not - claimed the reason for the All Nippon Airways (ANA) aircraft heading back to Los Angeles was because of a passenger who boarded the wrong flight. Her first tweet read: "a flying first for me: 4 hours into an 11 hour flight and we are turning around because we have a passenger who isn't supposed to be on this plane. Why ... why do we all gotta go back. I do not know (sic)" According to several reports, flight 175 landed back at LAX at approximately 7.30pm. Police officer Adonis Cutchlow of the LAPD did not explain why the plane had to be sent back, but simply said: "All we know is that it was turned around." Sharing a selfie of the pair posing in front of a giant snowman on Christmas Day on Instagram, Ryan wrote: "Happy Holidays (sic)" The 'Shameless' star said he's "thankful" for his little boy as he wished his followers all the best for the new year. Sharing a series of photographs in a video montage of the father and son posing by their Christmas tree, Ryan added: "#Winter17 Happy Holidays, Merry Christmas, & wishing you all a happier & healthier Happy New Year from them Dorsey dudes. I'm so thankful for this little dude, my main man, the sweetest boy I know. (sic)" Naya recently refilled for divorce from Ryan - two months after she withdrew her previous papers. The 30-year-old actress was arrested after she allegedly struck her estranged spouse over the head and in the mouth during a walk with Josey in West Virginia. Court papers obtained by TMZ.com stated that Naya made the move to submit legal documents to restart the termination of their marriage, citing "irreconcilable differences". The refiling came just two months after Naya called off their divorce proceedings when the pair - who wed in 2014 - reconciled following their split in November 2016. According to the newly filed papers,

Naya is seeking joint custody of Josey, and also wants the court to block either of them from getting spousal support. Ryan previously posted a statement about the alleged domestic battery incident on his social media accounts, where he asked for "positivity and love" during this "difficult time". He wrote: "This is a difficult time for everyone in the family especially for Naya and I. This isn't some reality show, this is our life, and I ask that everyone especially the media please respect our privacy and treat us/this situation how you would want a loved one to be treated. Perhaps with kindness, respect, without judgment, and as negative a situation this is, with positivity and love. Thanks." After papers were filed in 2016, they released a joint statement in which they said they would continue to be "great co-parenting partners" for their son. The statement read: "After much consideration, we have made the decision to end our marriage. Our priority is and always will be our beautiful son that we share together. We will continue to be great co-parenting partners for him. We ask for respect and privacy for our family during this difficult time."
