Helmy expressed his gratitude, "I am honored to receive the SciencesPo Student Paper Award for my senior thesis paper, and I am very grateful for the opportunity afforded by KFAS and the Kuwait Program at SciencesPo. I am also deeply indebted to AUK and to my supervisor, Dr Angelica DeAngelis who



provided strong guidance, endless encouragement, and indefatigable support throughout the research and writing process." Chosen among six winners, Helmy was awarded a cash prize along with publishing his paper in the Sciences Po Kuwait Program website.

The Kuwait Program is a partnership between the Kuwait Foundation for the Advancement of Sciences (KFAS) and Sciences Po-a social sciences university in France. The American University of Kuwait also has a standing student exchange program with Sciences Po that allows students to study at one of the school's seven urban campuses.
